'Decommissioning Offshore Oil Platforms, including single lift technology using Pioneering Spirit'

Captain Letty is an expert on marine towage, working for many years in the oil industry mainly in Scotland and Norway. He has been a leader in the development of the 'Pioneering spirit' project using a revolutionary and unique technique which has revolutionised decommissioning of redundant oil rigs, drilling platforms and other marine structures. This new technology allows for a much more eco-friendly piecemeal destructions of these structures ashore.
