Directions: The Museum is in Odun Road on the left as you enter Appledore. The Blue Lights Hall is tucked away at the bottom of this quaint narrow lane near the junction with Market Street. Car access is not possible because these streets are too narrow. People with reduced mobility should be dropped off at the bottom of Vernons Lane where it meets Appledore Quay.

Nearest Parking: There is a car park opposite the museum. For Blue lights Hall, Street parking in Churchfield Road or Appledore Quay. Car parking in Churchfield Car Park (3 minutes walk).

This meeting is open to friends of North Devon Maritime Museum and other local history societies

1.15 pm Jenny Arnold Growing up next to Richmond Dry Dock & family stories from World War two & beyond - eg: her grandfather's story – four Poles sailing in a local trader in WW2 and the artist skipper – general social history of Appledore.

2.15 pm Tom Brown 'Short Sharp Shanties' - sea songs of (Yankee Jack) John Short of Watchet who sailed for 50 years deepwater and local.

3.30 pm Alison Boyle (daughter of the late Alan Hinks) wooden boat building at the Hinks shipyard, Appledore, including 'Nonsuch' and 'Golden Hinde' replicas.
